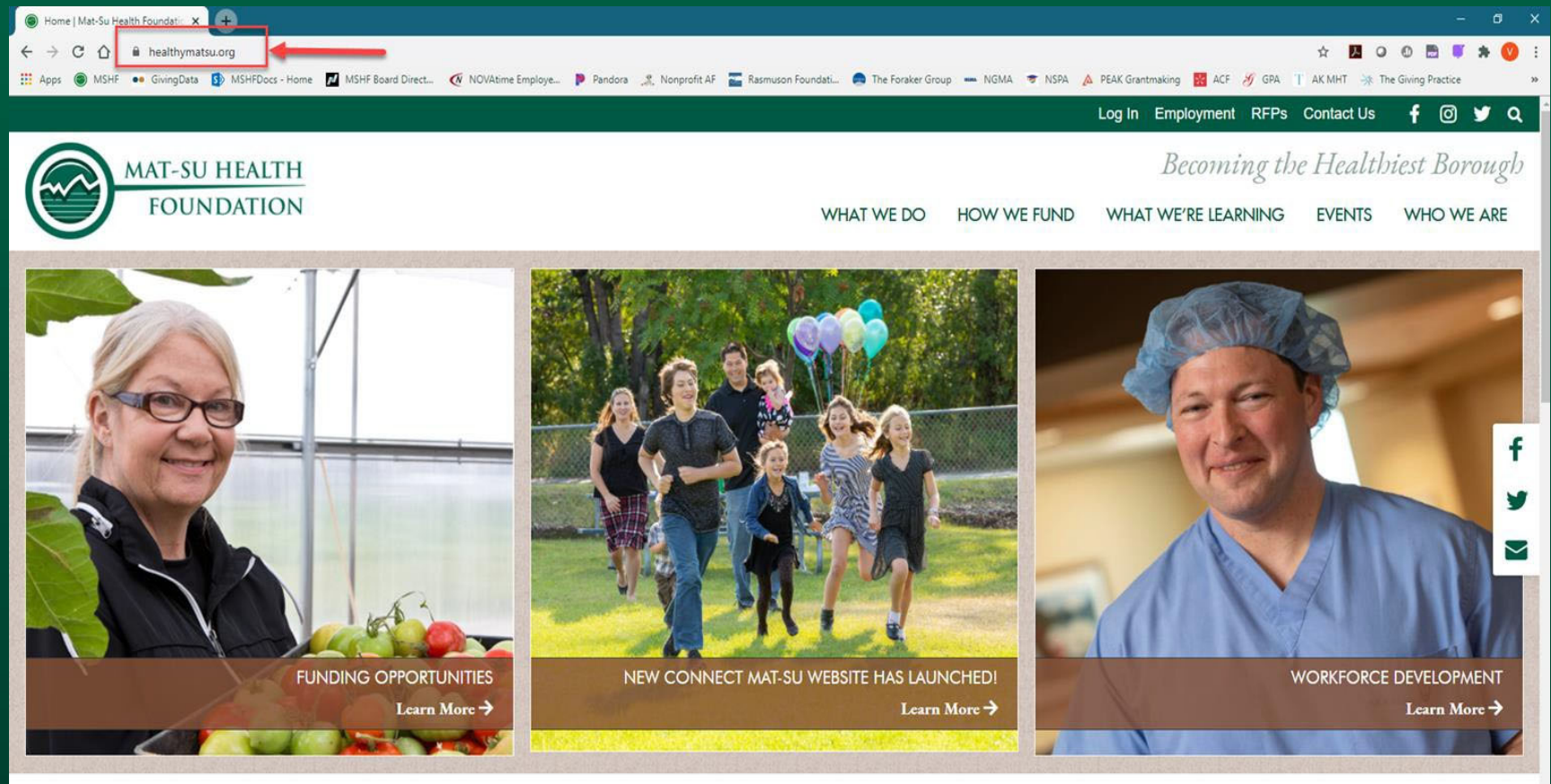



- Family members of a disqualified person include a disqualified person's spouse, brothers or sisters (whether by whole or half-blood), spouses of brothers or sisters (whether by whole or half-blood) and their children by whole or half blood or by adoption, ancestors, children (including a legally adopted child), grandchildren, great grandchildren, and spouses of children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren (whether by whole or half-blood).





Required Documents

To complete your application, you will need to upload three documents. Before you start, please be sure you have the following documents available:

- 1) Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) email confirmation Student Aid Report (SAR). Once you receive your FAFSA email confirmation or SAR, save it as a PDF or JPEG and upload it to your scholarship application. [Click here to see a sample FAFSA confirmation email](#). If you have not completed the FAFSA, you must do so before completing your Mat-Su Health Foundation scholarship application.
- 2) Proof of the Cost of Attendance for the school you plan to attend. This must include tuition, fees, books, room and board, etc. for the upcoming academic year. It can be in the form of a letter from the school you plan to attend or a screen shot from their website listing the official budget for Cost of Attendance, not to include summer course costs. - 3) Unofficial copy of your most recent transcript (high school, GED, college, or university).
