The 2021 application period is February 1 – March 31, 2021.

Mat-Su Health Foundation (MSHF) academic scholarships help defray the cost of higher education in degree programs in the fields of health and human services. APPLICATION PORTAL: Once you have created an account you should receive an activation link in the email you signed up with. Click the activation link to create a password and log in to your application landing page to start the application.

Required Documents

To complete your application, you will need to upload three documents. Before you start, please be sure you have the following documents available:

1) Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) email confirmation. Once you receive your FAFSA email confirmation, save it as a PDF or JPEG and upload it to your scholarship application. Click here to see a sample FAFSA confirmation email. If you have not yet completed the FAFSA, you must do so before completing your Mat-Su Health Foundation scholarship application.

2) Proof of the Cost of Attendance for the school you plan to attend. This must include tuition, fees, books, room and board, etc. for the upcoming academic year. It can be in the form of a letter from the school you plan to attend, or a screen shot from their website listing the official budget for Cost of Attendance, not to include summer course costs. Click here to see an example of proof of Cost of Attendance.

3) Unofficial copy of your most recent transcript (high school, college, or university).
